#### **CRITERIA FOR JUDGES LISTS**

#### A1 List

The A1 List indicates all persons whom the Club would support (this requires acceptance by the Club's Judges Committee) and who have been previously approved by the Kennel Club to award Challenge Certificates in the breed and who have carried out the appointment. (KC Policy)

#### A2 List

The A2 list indicates all persons who fulfil all the requirements for the A3 list, who have been assessed in accordance with Kennel Club requirements and accepted by the Kennel Club for inclusion on an A2 list, and have the support of the Club's Judges Committee for inclusion on an A2 list. (KC policy)

## **A3 List (Breed Specialists)**

#### Requirements:

- 1 Minimum of 7 years judging experience in this breed and have the support of the WHWT Club of England. (KC Policy)
- 2. To have judged at 2 Breed Club Shows or Northern Cairn & WHWT Club and Midland Counties Scottish Terrier and WHWT Club.
- 3. To have judged this Breed with an adequate geographical spread.
- 4. To have judged a minimum of 35 classes in this breed.
- 5. To have judged a minimum of 110 dogs in this breed.
- To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs when they obtained their first entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (save in exceptional circumstances) (KC Policy)
- 7. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures. (KC Policy)
- 8. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement. (KC Policy)
- 9. To have attended a 'Points Of The Dog Assessment' conducted by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the assessment. (KC Policy)
- 10. To have attended at least 1 Breed Specific Seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable. (KC Policy)
- 11 To have stewarded at 12 shows (KC Policy).

## A3 List (non specialists)

#### Requirements:

- 1. Minimum of 7 years judging experience in any one breed (to include 5 years in this breed) and have the support of the WHWT Club of England (KC Policy).
- 2. To have judged this breed at 20 Open Shows or Championship Shows without CCs with an adequate geographical spread.
- 3. To have judged a minimum of 35 classes in this breed.
- 4. To have judged 110 dogs in this breed. (KC Policy/Club Policy)
- 5. To have awarded CCs in at least one other breed (KC Policy).
- 6. To have attended at least 1 Breed Specific Seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable.
- 7. To have stewarded at 12 Shows.
- 8. To have bred and/or owned a minimum of 3 dogs of any breed when they obtained their first entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book (Save in exceptional circumstances).

## **B List (Breed Specialists)**

- 1. To have 5 years experience owning and exhibiting in this breed and to have the support of the WHWT Club of England.
- 2. To have judged 15 classes of this breed at Open or Championship Shows without CCs
- 3. To have judged 35 dogs of this breed.
- 4. To have attended at least 1 Breed Specific Seminar run in accordance with the relevant Kennel Club Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment where applicable.

# **B List (Non Specialists)**

- 1. To have a minimum of 5 years judging experience in any one breed and have the support of the WHWT Club of England.
- 2. To have judged 15 classes of this breed at Open or Championship Shows without CCs (Save in exceptional circumstances)
- 3. To have judged 35 dogs of this breed.

For Aspirant judges who have shown an interest in the breed and have the support of the WHWT Club of England.
